Cornell notes are arranged in a way that helps you organize your notes, so you can find important information more easily.

- Divide the paper into three sections. Recall, Note-taking, Summary
- Fill in the course information or bibliography at the top of the page

Note + taking Column

- Take notes on the right side. Skip a line between ideas and topics.
- Do not use complete sentences. Use abbreviations

Recall Column

- Pull out main ideas, key words or points, dates, people and vocabulary and write these in the left column.
- Formulate questions based on the notes in the right hand column.
- Writing questions helps to clarify meaning and strengthen memory.
- The questions serve as a study guide for later use.
- After writing and reviewing your questions reflect further to determine if you need more information or have additional questions about the topic



Summary: WWII began 9/1939 when Hitler invaded Poland. Germany, Italy, and Japan = axis of power; the U.S., Gr. Britain, and the Soviet Union = grand alliance after 1941. Hitler's main goal was to get more territory/security and execute the Jews (the Final Solution). America entered war in 1941 when Japan attacked Pearl Harbor.
