


<p>Why use Cornell notes? X</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cornell notes are arranged in a way that helps you organize your notes, so you can find important information more easily.</li> </ul>
<p>How do I setup my paper for notes?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Set-up</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Divide the paper into three sections. Recall, Note-taking, Summary</li> <li>• Fill in the course information or bibliography at the top of the page</li> </ul>
<p>Note-taking column</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Note-taking Column</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Take notes on the right side. Skip a line between ideas and topics.</li> <li>• Do not use complete sentences. Use abbreviations</li> </ul>
<p>Recall Column</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Recall Column</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pull out main ideas, key words or points, dates, people and vocabulary and write these in the left column.</li> <li>• Formulate questions based on the notes in the right hand column.</li> <li>• Writing questions helps to clarify meaning and strengthen memory.</li> <li>• The questions serve as a study guide for later use.</li> <li>• After writing and reviewing your questions reflect further to determine if you need more information or have additional questions about the topic</li> </ul>
<p>How can the recall column help me study for a test? X</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Test Review</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cover the note taking column with a sheet of paper and using the cue words or questions in the left column to answer the questions in your own words.</li> </ul>
<p>Summary</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Summary</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write a summary of the main ideas in the bottom section. Use only your notes to write your summary. Begin writing your summary only after your resource has been closed.</li> <li>• The summary should only be a few sentences. It should be in your own words.</li> </ul>
<p>What goes at the top of the page?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Bibliography</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Course info: Name, date, topic, class</li> <li>• Bibliography: Title, author, publisher, publishing city, date, website</li> </ul>

Cue Column	Notes
What triggered WWII?	Germany invaded Poland in 9/1939.
Why?	Said Germany needed lebensraum "living space" (territory)
Axis of Power:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Germany</li> <li>◆ Japan</li> <li>◆ Italy</li> <li>◆ Soviet Union (allied w/Germany from 1939-6/22/41)</li> </ul>
Why did Japan and Italy support Germany?	Japan wanted to take over east Asia. Italy wanted to take over the Mediterranean and the Balkans by taking advantage of Germany's success.
Grand Alliance:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ U.S.</li> <li>◆ Soviet Union (after 9/41 and Lend-Lease agreement)</li> <li>◆ Great Britain</li> </ul>
What was Lend-Lease?	Allowed the U.S. to sell, transfer, exchange, lend equipment to the Allies.
What was Hitler's plan?	Final Solution- plan to execute all Jews in Europe. Extend German territory.
Different kinds of camps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ Labor- open when hard labor was needed</li> <li>◆ Extermination- eliminates "undesirables"</li> <li>◆ Concentration- work to death (starvation/disease)</li> <li>◆ Transit and Collection- German efficiency- routing</li> </ul>
Other prisoners:	Homosexuals, Gypsies, Communists, and Jehovah's witnesses
U.S. enters war:	U.S. enters war 12/41 Entered because of the attack on Pearl Harbor by Japan.
How did U.S. support Britain and France before entering the war?	Gave machinery, weapon, and ammunition.
<b>Summary:</b> WWII began 9/1939 when Hitler invaded Poland. Germany, Italy, and Japan = axis of power; the U.S., Gr. Britain, and the Soviet Union = grand alliance after 1941. Hitler's main goal was to get more territory/security and execute the Jews (the Final Solution). America entered war in 1941 when Japan attacked Pearl Harbor.
