LaSalle Students and Families:

Thank you for considering our trip to Washington, D.C. from April 4 through April 8, 2018. Below you will find information related to signing up for the trip and our expectations for students who do.

As in the past, students and families can sign up for the trip on a first-come basis. Registration information can be found on the Greuninger Tours flyer. We have a total of 64 spots available for students who wish to go. Those spots will be filled by the first 64 students to sign up and make their first installment payment (due October 15). We therefore recommend signing up and making the first payment for the trip as soon as possible only if a student is seriously considering going. Students who sign up but do not make their first payment will be automatically dropped from the list. A "wait list" will be created for students who were not among the first 64 to sign up and/or pay.

Students will have the opportunity to pick their roommates for when we stay at our hotel in the Washington area. In order to keep costs down, there will be four students of the same gender in each room. More information about roommate requests will be forthcoming after Fall Break once students have made it onto the list of those going.

It is important to note that this will be a school-related event and all SBCSC guidelines from the Code of Conduct will therefore apply. Students who are disruptive or continually do not follow directions on the trip will be subject to consequences when we return, including non-participation in the special events we have planned at the end of the school year. In addition, any student who receives one full day—or the equivalent—OSS (out of school suspension) or 2 or more full days—or the equivalent—ISS (in school suspension) assignments between October 23 and March 29 will be disqualified from going on the trip. Those students will have their money refunded at the request of LaSalle administrators, but it should be noted that, per our contract with Greuninger, a full refund will not be given (cancellation penalties start at 25%).

Thank you again for considering this wonderful trip. By signing up, each student and family agrees to the contents of this letter.
